Would you like to be more involved in your child's class room? Would you like to work more closely with the teacher?

Each year the Parent Advisory Council organizes a roster of two parents from each division to act as Class Parents for their child's class. This role is important to improve the communication between teacher, parents and the PAC. The work that these parents do is greatly appreciated and goes a long way towards making the school a better place for our children. You and your co-Class Parent act as facilitators and get other parents involved in supporting the teacher in the classroom.

Some of the duties of the Class Parents include:

- Becoming the communication hub for the parents in your class. This involves making e-mail contact with the families in the class to create a class contact list, and forwarding e-mail's from the PAC and the school to the parents in your class.**
- Assisting the teacher throughout the year with special projects, organizing drivers for field trips, organizing scrap books, crafts, bulletin boards... whatever the teacher could use help with. This may involve organizing a roster of parents from your class to help out.**
- Attending PAC meetings once a month (the last Monday of each month at 7pm in the Library. Child minding provided. No meeting in the months of December, March and June).**
- Assisting the teacher with holiday and year end class parties.**
- Assisting with any fundraising activities including distributing Special Foods to the class.**
